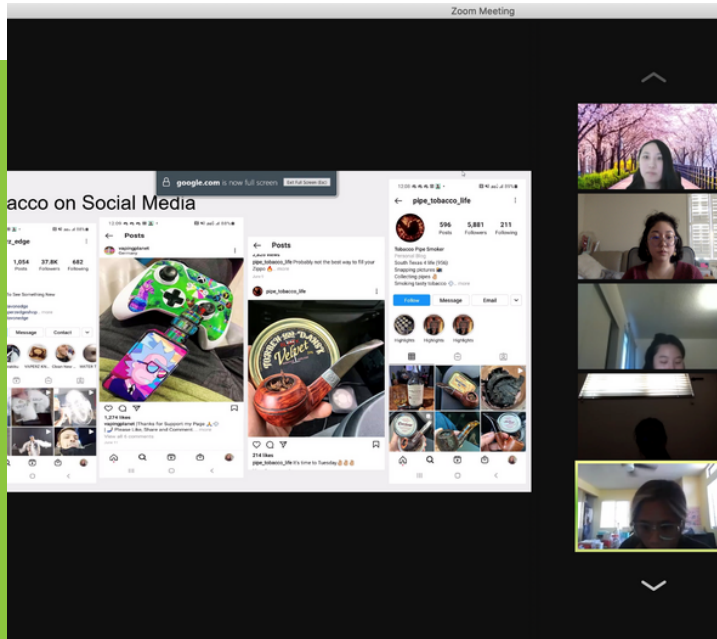

CALFRESH HEALTH LIVING

APIFM partnered with the LA County Department of Public Health (LAC-DPH) on the CalFresh Health Living (CFHL) program in order to distribute produce to local community health clinics and community based organizations across Los Angeles County.

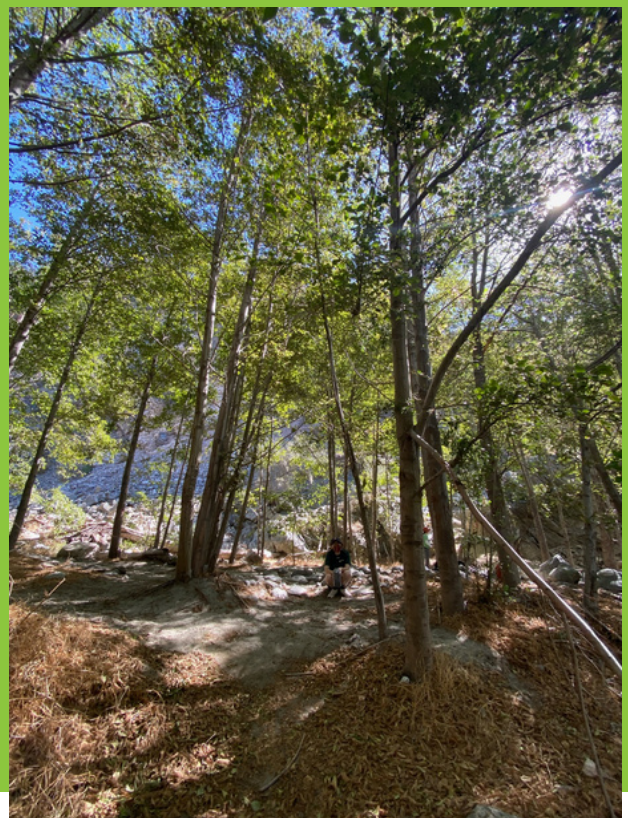

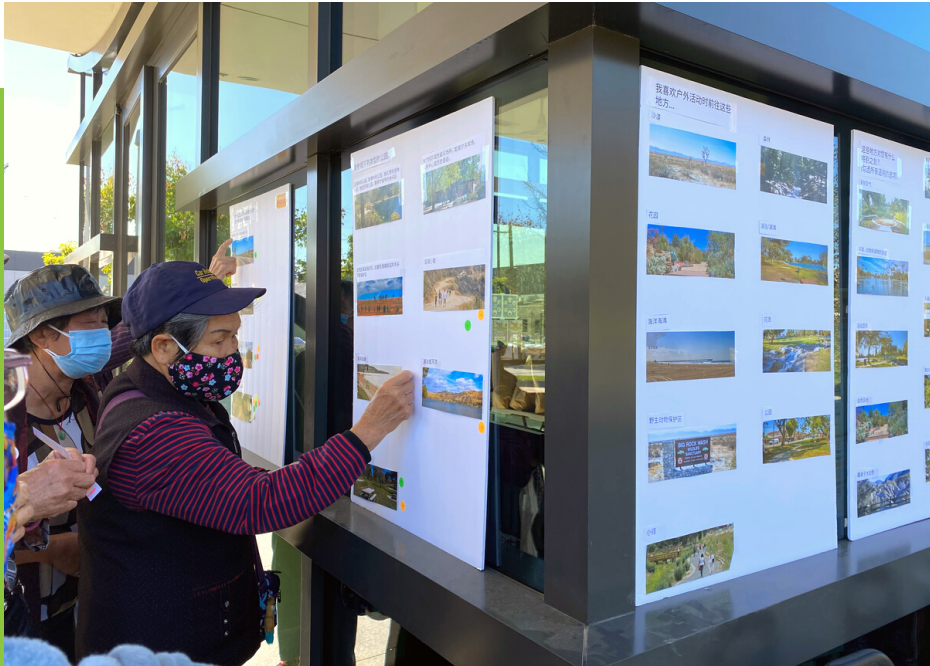
