


SECONDHAND SMOKE IN OUTDOOR AREAS

The California Air Resources Board declared secondhand smoke a Toxic Air Contaminant in 2016.¹




California currently does not have a comprehensive outdoor smoking policy, though 72% of California voters support a ban on smoking in public outdoor areas.²

113 cities and counties in California have comprehensive outdoor secondhand smoke policies.³

200 California cities and counties have smoke-free park policies.⁴

More than 100 California cities have enacted smoke-free outdoor dining and bar patio laws.⁴
