OUR PROGRAMS



FOOD ROOTS HARVEST (FRH)

FRH is a community food hub that expands access to culturally relevant, affordable, and healthy fresh foods by partnering with small farmers and food rescue organizations. Inedible produce is recycled back to the earth through our composting partners.



FOOD ROOTS NOURISH (FRN)

FRN hosts culturally relevant nutrition education, produce distributions, community gardening, cooking workshops, and accessible Tai Chi classes & Qi Gong classes.

The Community Health team provides culturally tailored wellness information and expands food access for Pacific Islander communities through local partnerships.

The Enroll LA team offers in-language help to overcome CalFresh enrollment barriers.





SUSTAINABLE SAN GABRIEL VALLEY (SSGV)
